



# VIDEO IN QUICKTIME PLAYER



1 Open SPOTLIGHT; type "QUICK"  
Quick Time Player should show up.



2 From the FILE menu, choose NEW MOVIE RECORDING.

## ProTips


Make sure there are no bright lights behind.

Move side-to-side, not toward or away from the camera


Don't move too fast.

3 SAVE the video somewhere you'll remember!

# Insert Movie in Logger Pro




1 Open SPOTLIGHT; type LOGGER  
Logger Pro should show up.



2 From the INSERT menu,  
choose MOVIE...

3 Browse and select  
your video.




4 Resize the video to be nice and big

5 Click the Dot Tool Bar Button



It didn't. It's just behind the graph. Resize the graph smaller and you'll see it.



6 Click the Dot Maker.

7 Drag the slider to get the video to just before the action starts.


8 Choose some part of the object to click on. Click on it, and the video will advance automatically. Keep clicking on it!

## ProTips

Don't do a million dots. Just do enough to get the idea of what was happening.

Don't put dots on top of dots; It'll be too hard to read. Just stop there.

## If You Mess Up and Want to Start Over



To erase all your dots:  
Click DATA in the menu.  
Choose CLEAR ALL DATA.
